- A. 90 (show-up) points will be awarded to all members in good standing, who attempt to qualify a car, but fails to qualify for the feature event.
- B. Platinum teams on Super DIRTcar Series are required to run up to 8 weekly shows, either Big Block or 358 Modifieds. Each show attended between April and Labor Day weekend will earn 100 points. Points will then be added to Super DIRTcar Series points after Labor Day.
- C. If a race is cancelled and rescheduled and a member in good standing is unable to return due to extenuating circumstances, then that member may be awarded show-up points if they were present and prepared to race on the original date.

- D. Points will be awarded special events, as agreed with members in good standing, utilizing show-up points only.
- E. In the event of a tie that occurs during the season, the driver that placed highest in the most recent completed event will be listed ahead in the overall Championship Point Standings. The order is created by wins, top 5s, top 10s, last completed event.
- F. In the event that a tie should occur in the final Championship Point Standings at the end of the season, the tie will be broken using the following tiebreakers in order; Most feature wins, most second place finishes, most third place finishes, etc. until the tie is broken. In the event that the tie remains unbroken by finishes the tiebreaker will result to qualifying results in the same manner.

- A. If a race is cancelled and rescheduled and a member in good standing is unable to return due to extenuating circumstances, then that member may be awarded show-up points if they were present and prepared to race on the original date.
- B. If a race is cancelled after qualifying have been completed due to inclement weather 'show up' points will be awarded to each driver in attendance.
- C. For Super DIRTcar Big Block Modified Series events, unless otherwise noted, fastest time and qualifying race points will be awarded. The driver posting the fastest time in qualifying, 5-points will be awarded. Qualifying race points will be as follows: 1.) 5-points 2.) 4-points 3.) 3-points. 4) 2-points, 5) 1-point.
- D. At all Super DIRTcar Big Block Modified Series events, any Platinum Member who competes with a car that does not have a DIRTcar Big Block Modified engine as set forth in section 15.1 of the rule book will forfeit 90 Championship Points.
- E. In the event that a tie should occur in the final Championship Point Standings at the end of the season, the tie will be broken by referencing and ranking the tied competitors by the greatest number of first (1st) place finishes. If the tie still exists then the tie will be broken by the greatest number of second (2nd) place, third (3rd) place, etc., finishes until the tie is broken.

- F. The Hoosier Tire Weekly Championship is based on a driver's season long best 16 finishes in the listed divisions in any DIRTcar sanctioned, non-Series point event for those divisions, from January 1 until the Sunday of Labor Day weekend each calendar year.
 - a. Super DIRTcar Big Block Modified Series
 - b. DIRTcar 358 Modified
 - c. DIRTcar Sportsman Modified
 - d. DIRTcar Pro Stock Series

10.2.1 BONUS POINT SCHEDULE

- A. This section applies to DIRTcar Big Block Modifieds, DIRTcar 358 Modifieds, DIRTcar NE Sportsman and DIRTcar Pro Stocks
- B. Super DIRTcar Series Big Block Overall Point Standings will be computed by points earned at Series races only. For the 358/Sportsman/Pro Stock Series Overall Point Standings may be computed by points earned at Series races to Track Bonus Points, issued after Labor Day Weekend. Track Bonus points are based on a driver's best "home" track standings and also to Regional Series Bonus Points
- C. Track points will be awarded by DIRTcar for all events provided the events and cars in competition are governed by the DIRTcar rulebook, unless sanctioned event is by invitation or otherwise stated. The number of cars in the heats, consolation, and feature races is determined by each individual track.
- D. Track points will be awarded to drivers only. A driver must run a reasonable number of events (50%) at a track to use that track for home track bonus points. Double point and/or championship points may be awarded at certain events throughout the season. Home track bonus points are awarded after Monday of Labor Day weekend. They are awarded to a driver based on his "best" track performance.
- E. Any track running a mixed (358-Modified/Modified) division, in order to be awarded home track bonus points and track point fund money secured by DIRTcar for the 358 class, must have at least five (5) 358 modified cars in the field in order for those points to count.
- F. A class at a DIRTcar sanctioned track, in order to be eligible to receive home track points and track champion money, must have at least Five (5) scheduled events for that division and complete a reasonable number of those events. Exceptions can be made by written permission from DIRTcar if a track loses an unusually high number of shows to weather or other reasons.
- G. All tracks must submit an Official DIRTcar Race Report Summary Sheet to (Gary Spaid — aces2@frontiernet.net) within 24 hours after the conclusion of the event in order for track points to be awarded.
- H. Rookie of the Year titles are awarded in Modified, 358-Modified, Sportsman and Pro Stock classes. Rookie of the Year is determined by a driver's home track points, starts and points from the Super DIRTcar Series and Mr. DIRTcar races. A Rookie Ballot will be sent out to DIRTcar NE officials to determine these rookie award winners.

- I. A rookie is defined as any driver who has not competed in more than six DIRTcar feature events in the particular division in which he/she is competing for rookie of the year title. The progression must be upward; for example, no modified driver can compete for 358-modified rookie of the year. Drivers attempting to run for rookie of the year in any division must notify DIRTcar in writing by July 31.
