## **Sportsman/Pro Stock Licensed Competitors Running 358/Big Block Events.**

### **Rulebook Section 7. Restrictions:**

- a. A Pro Stock and/or Sportsman driver may race in a DIRTcar Big Block Modified and/or 358 Modified sanctioned with approval by a WRG Supervisory Officials.

### **The following guidelines have been set up for more clarity:**

- 1.) A Sportsman/Pro Stock licensed driver may run up to six (6) events in a current year. To count as an event, driver would be qualified and run a feature event. Once a driver reaches the sixth event he/she will either stay sportsman or move up to 358/Big Block. (Driver must also upgrade to 358/Big Block license).
- 2.) A Sportsman/Pro Stock licensed driver however will only be permitted to run one class when a Super DIRTcar/358 Series event is being held on the same night. This will apply to all events before and on Labor Day Weekend.
- 3.) After Labor Day Weekend, a Sportsman/Pro Stock licensed driver will be permitted to run both classes with a Super DIRTcar/358 Series event which includes Oswego.
- 4.) If a driver wants to run both classes on a regular point night, status to do so will be at the track's discretion. (You must reach out to the track before arrival).
- 5.) A Sportsman/Pro Stock Driver once he/she hits a **"lifetime total"** of twelve (12) feature events while a Sportsman or Pro Stock licensed member he/she will be required to move up to 358 or Big Block class. (Ex. If you did run six (6) events in 2020, you may only run six (6) more in any period after that).
- 6.) When a driver does want to move up to 358/Big Block that driver must reach out to Dean Reynolds before competing.

### **Rulebook Section 7 Restrictions:**

- c. Any driver who possesses a current or previous year DIRTcar Big Block Modified and/or 358 Modified membership license will not be permitted to compete in any DIRTcar sanctioned Sportsman Modified, Pro Stock and/or Stock Car event without approval by a WRG Supervisory Officials.
